SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

Maintains, repairs and operates building automation systems and all associated equipment within the facility/energy centre.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- ◆ Journeyperson Electrical certificate
or
- ◆ Journeyperson Mechanical certificate

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- ◆ Advanced computer skills
- ◆ Ability to work independently
- ◆ Analytical skills
- ◆ Communication, organizational and interpersonal skills

EXPERIENCE:

- ◆ **Previous:** Nine (9) months post-ticket experience in an industrial/commercial maintenance environment including controls experience.

KEY ACTIVITIES:

A. Maintain / Repair / Service Control Systems

- ◆ Troubleshoots, repairs, installs, calibrates, adjusts, monitors, replaces control systems and equipment as required, including fire systems.
- ◆ Modifies and programs software for control systems.
- ◆ Designs graphics for control systems.
- ◆ Burns EPROM's.
- ◆ Performs diagnostics on control systems.
- ◆ Loads computer programs for control systems.
- ◆ Monitors and programs critical alarms.
- ◆ Monitors emergency power systems within facility.

B. Preventative Maintenance

- ◆ Checks and maintains control system components and related mechanical/electrical equipment throughout the facility.
- ◆ Provides input into the preventative maintenance program, and keeps appropriate records.
- ◆ Performs vibration analysis on specific equipment.

C. Equipment Repair

- ◆ Repairs pumps, fans, motors, dampers, valves, compressors, heat exchangers, humidifiers, ventilation units, filters, sprinkler systems, mixing boxes, sensors, hydronic systems.
- ◆ Provides air balancing.
- ◆ Repairs steam systems and associated equipment in accordance with Saskatchewan Boiler and Pressure Vessel Act.
- ◆ Fabricates parts.

D. Projects / Renovations

- ◆ Fabricates and installs HVAC systems.
- ◆ Commissions the start up of HVAC systems.
- ◆ Works with and coordinates contractors, as required.
- ◆ Provides technical advice and input to consultants and engineers.

E. Related Key Work Activities

- ◆ Provides occasional guidance to the primary function of others, including training.
- ◆ Performs asbestos abatement, where trained and required by the job.
- ◆ Ensures that “as-built” drawings are updated.
- ◆ Purchases supplies and parts.
- ◆ Leads projects, including other trades and contractors.
