<p><b>Experience</b></p> <p>No previous experience. Six (6) months on the job to become familiar with facility layout, laundry services, waste disposal, biohazard waste and sharps disposal, and region/facility/department policies and procedures.</p>	<p><u>2.0</u></p>
<p><b>Independent Judgement</b></p> <p>Uses established methods when transporting waste and laundry. Has some choice of action in prioritizing work.</p>	<p><u>2.0</u></p>
<p><b>Working Relationships</b></p> <p>Requires courtesy when discussing issues with other staff and waste contractors.</p>	<p><u>1.5</u></p>

<p>Provides waste/laundry portering services within set practices to meet quality and service requirements.</p> <p>Mislabeling of biohazardous waste may require the work of others to trace. Damage may occur if not diligent when transporting expensive equipment.</p>	<u>1.5</u>
<p><b>Leadership and/or Supervision</b></p> <p>Provides occasional orientation to staff.</p>	<u>1.0</u>
<p><b>Physical Demands</b></p> <p>Frequent cumulative physical effort including standing, crouching, pushing, and pulling with periods of heavy lifting.</p>	<u>3.0</u>
<p><b>Sensory Demands</b></p> <p>Occasional sensory effort using compactor, visual awareness when moving equipment, and listening to other staff.</p>	<u>1.0</u>
<p><b>Environment</b></p> <p>Regular major disagreeable conditions such as blood/body fluids, soiled linen, chemicals, noise, sharps and unpredictable weights (e.g., garbage bags).</p>	<u>4.0</u>

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
